Hypothesis Oakville Cabernet Sauvignon showcases the character and power that have made Money Road Vineyard in Oakville one of Napa Valley's most sought-after Cabernet sites. Thoughtfully blended with small lots of Malbec from acclaimed Napa vineyards, this wine offers layered complexity and refined structure without sacrificing richness or approachability.

The result is a Cabernet that is bold yet balanced, showing generous flavors of cassis, blackberry, and ripe plum, framed by hints of espresso and cocoa. Rich and polished on the palate, Hypothesis offers both immediate appeal and the ability to evolve with time, making it a standout expression of Oakville's character.

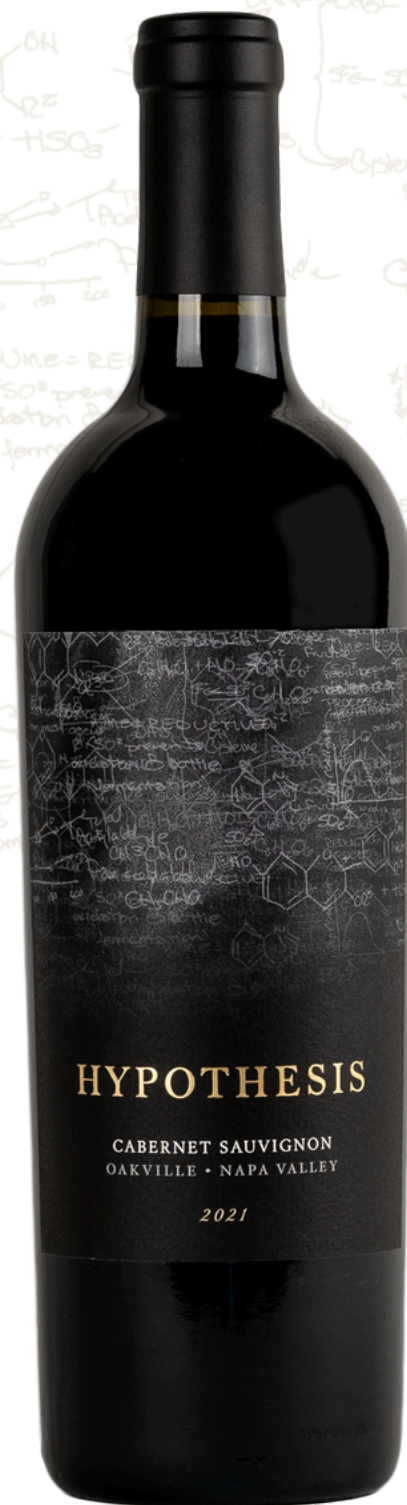
