The Wine

Sourced from the lower elevation blocks of the Our Lady of Guadalupe Vineyard, where sandy loam soils and the moderating influence of coastal fog create a gentle growing environment at the far western edge of the Sta. Rita Hills AVA. The maritime air rolls in consistently from the Pacific, slowing ripening and coaxing a delicate, lifted character from the vine – preserving the bright acidity and floral precision that define this site's most elegant expression of Pinot Noir.

Graceful and refined, with the kind of freshness and finesse that shines at the table and rewards an unhurried evening.
