### The Wine

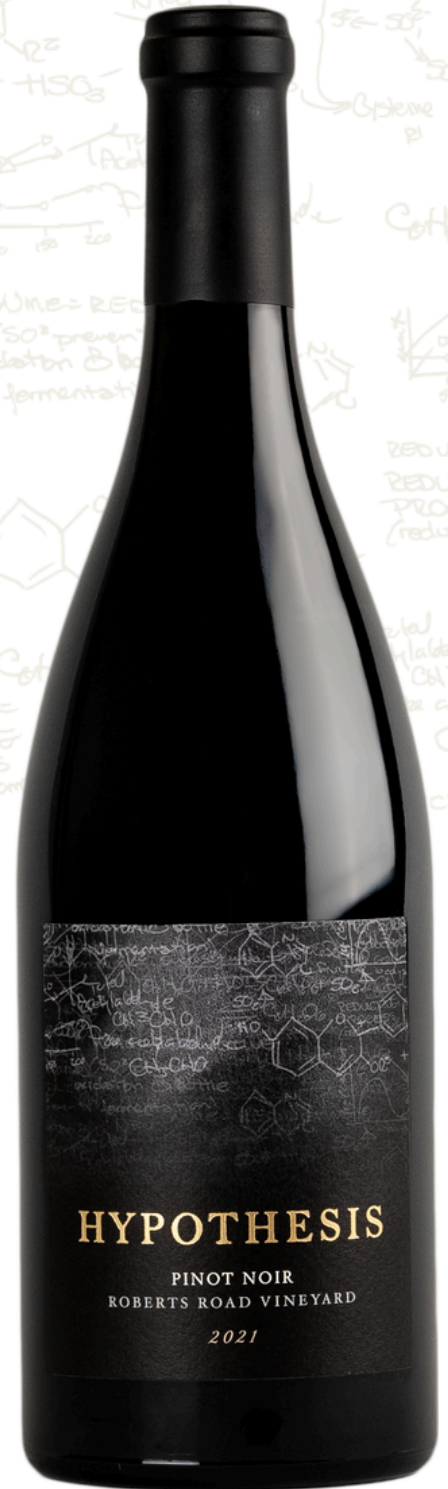
This 2022 Hypothesis Pinot Noir comes from Roberts Road Vineyard, situated in the heart of the Petaluma Gap – a narrow coastal corridor where powerful Pacific winds funnel through daily, stressing the vines and slowing ripening to a crawl. That relentless wind pressure produces small, thick-skinned berries with concentrated structure and cool-climate acidity that you simply don't find in more sheltered Sonoma sites.

The result is a bold, structured Pinot Noir with the kind of grip and depth that even Cabernet lovers will appreciate.
