A full-bodied North Coast Cabernet Sauvignon anchored by fruit from the volcanic soils of Beckstoffer Crimson Ridge Vineyard in Lake County, blended with Cabernet from Oakville and Rutherford in Napa Valley. The multi-region approach is deliberate — each source contributes something specific, and the Napa Valley component adds the depth and polish that elevates this wine above its tier. Well-priced, with a blending story that's easy to communicate and a quality level that speaks for itself.

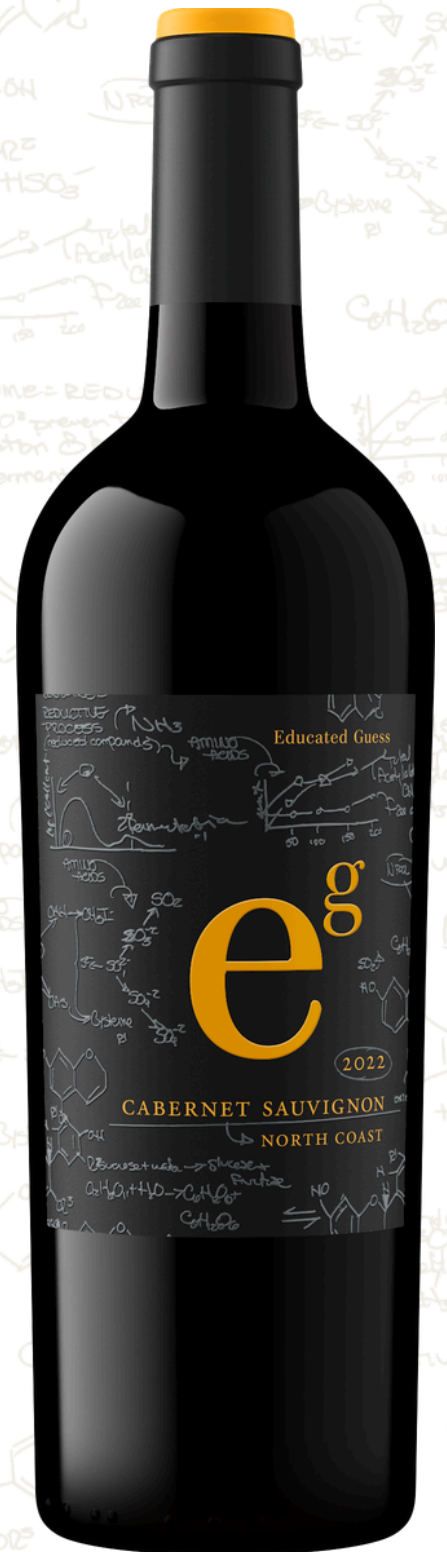
