That insight became the winery's founding idea, and its first wine: Educated Guess Napa County Cabernet Sauvignon. To fund that first vintage, Mark sold his house and nearly everything in it. Friends and family who believed in the vision helped turn that leap into a working winery.

More than twenty years later, Roots Run Deep sources fruit primarily from Napa Valley vineyards, while also working with exceptional growers in Sonoma and across California — always in pursuit of the same thing: wines that overdeliver on quality, character, and value.

Roots Run Deep Winery was founded in 2005 by Mark Albrecht — a wine industry veteran who had spent decades working across every level of the business, from boutique wine bars and retail shops to high-end restaurants and national chains. What he kept seeing was a gap: customers who wanted great wine but found the best bottles either out of budget or made to feel out of reach.

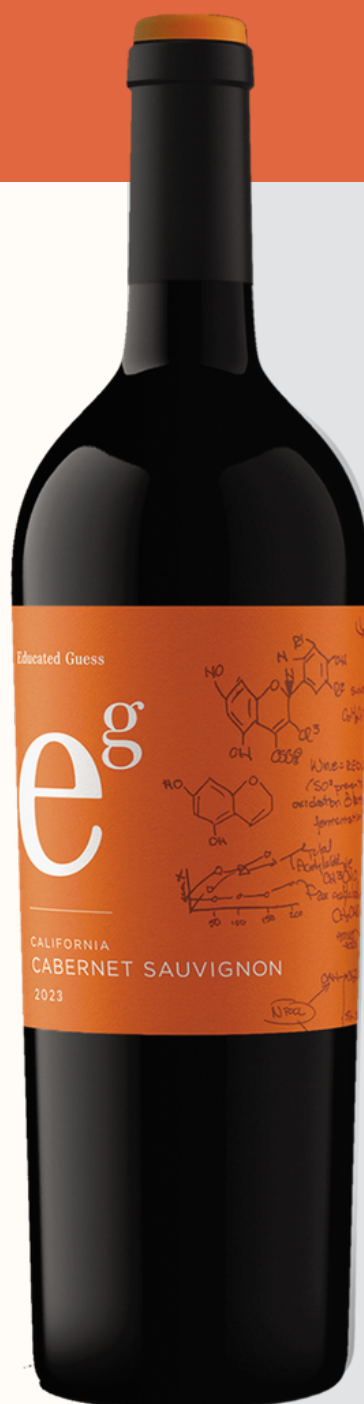

EG BY EDUCATED GUESS Cabernet Sauvignon CALIFORNIA

Our California Cabernet Sauvignon draws on the extraordinary diversity of the state deliberately – pulling from exceptional growing regions including Beckstoffer Crimson Ridge Vineyard in Lake County and celebrated Lodi vineyards, and aged 12 months in French oak. Petite Sirah adds depth and spice, while splashes of Petit Verdot and Malbec round out the finish. Bright, fruit-forward, and approachable from the very first pour.

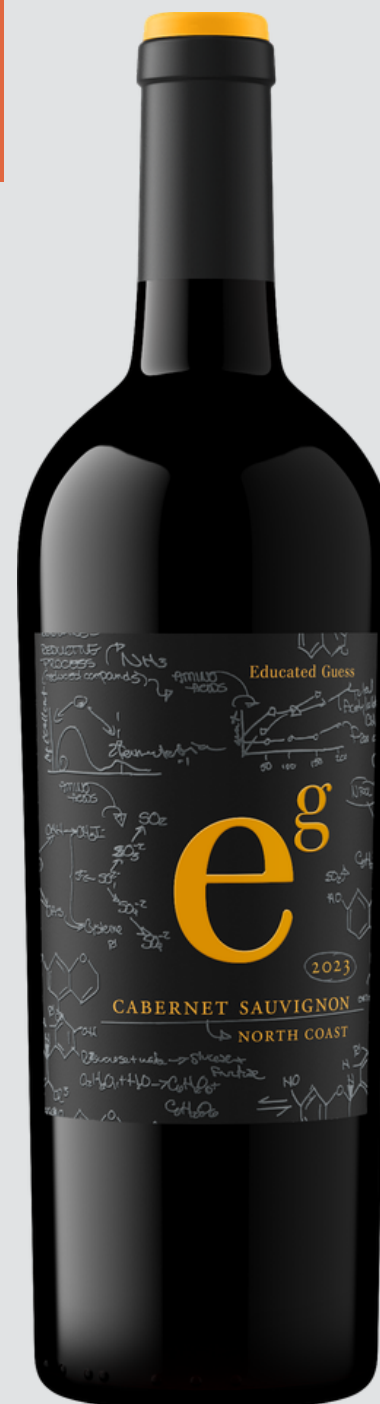
Since its launch, this wine has become one of our fastest-growing SKUs – a million-dollar wine nationally, ranked #83 in the \$10–\$15 all-varietal category, with over 80% growth in Nielsen 52-week data. Awarded 91 points and a Best Buy from Wine Enthusiast.



EG BY EDUCATED GUESS Cabernet Sauvignon NORTH COAST

Don't let the appellation fool you. Our North Coast Cabernet draws on fruit from some of California's most respected growing regions – anchored by Beckstoffer Crimson Ridge Vineyard in Lake County, known for its volcanic soils and extended hang time, and blended with Cabernet from Oakville and Rutherford for the elegance and polish that Napa Valley delivers at its best. Aged 12 months in French oak, the result is luscious and full-bodied, with a depth and complexity that competes well above its tier.

Consistently recognized with 90+ scores from major publications, this is the wine that bridges everyday California Cabernet and luxury Napa Valley – serious pedigree at an accessible price.



EG BY EDUCATED GUESS Red Blend NAPA VALLEY

The kind of red blend that makes the whole table happy – and that's entirely by design. Merlot brings generous fruit and softness, Cabernet Sauvignon adds structure and depth, and Petite Sirah delivers the richness and full-bodied character that completes the blend. Together they produce something more complete and more interesting than any single variety could achieve on its own. Sourced from premium Napa Valley fruit – a rarity at this price point for a red blend – and consistently recognized by major publications. Broad cross-consumer appeal and equally at home on a restaurant wine list, a retail shelf, or a backyard table.



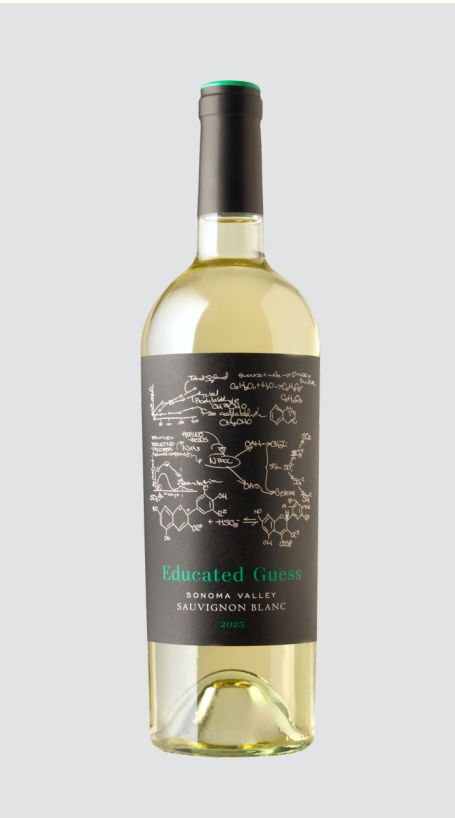

WHY EDUCATED GUESS?

Choosing wine shouldn't feel like a test. But between the labels, the vintages, and the endless variables, it can. Truthfully? We face the same thing in the vineyard and the cellar every single day. Great winemaking lives at the intersection of science and instinct — combining data, chemistry, and experience with the kind of human intuition that no formula can fully replace. Despite all of it, every vintage still comes down to a series of high-stakes educated guesses. We've spent years obsessing over those variables — the sun, the oak, the timing — so that when you pull the cork, there's no guesswork left. Just great wine.



EDUCATED GUESS Sauvignon Blanc SONOMA VALLEY

Fresh, bright, and genuinely versatile, this Sonoma Valley Sauvignon Blanc is fermented in equal parts stainless steel and neutral oak barrel — a deliberate split that preserves the variety's natural acidity and citrus-driven character while adding a subtle roundness and texture that sets it apart. A white wine that works as hard at the dinner table as it does anywhere else.

EDUCATED GUESS Chardonnay SONOMA COAST

Sourced from fog-cooled vineyards in the Russian River Valley along the Sonoma Coast, this Chardonnay is 100% barrel fermented — some in new oak, some in older barrels — building richness, texture, and depth while retaining the natural acidity and tropical fruit character the appellation is known for. The mix of new and neutral oak adds complexity without overwhelming the wine's natural character. Indistinguishable in quality from its higher-priced competitors.



EDUCATED GUESS Pinot Noir SONOMA COAST

Our Pinot Noir is sourced from carefully selected vineyard sites in the Russian River Valley and Petaluma Gap — two of California's most celebrated appellations for the variety. Blended from four distinct clones — Martini, Pommard, and Dijon 115 and 777 — each chosen for what it contributes to the finished wine, it's a Pinot that consistently earns more attention than it asks for. Aged 12 months in French oak. This wine sells out of the winery the fastest and is a great addition to any restaurant wine list or independent retailer's shelf.



EDUCATED GUESS Merlot NAPA VALLEY

Our Napa Merlot was created with a distinct mission: to generate interest and excitement in a grape that years ago fell out of fashion. This noble variety produces some of the world's most interesting wines — provided the vineyards are properly located and well-maintained, with a focus on low yields and intense flavors. We've chosen two ideal sites on the valley floor, one in the heart of Oakville and the other in Oak Knoll. A portion is barrel fermented to provide structure and complexity, finished with Cabernet Sauvignon to further its intensity and age-ability. Named a Top 100 Wine of the Year by Wine Enthusiast, and consistently recognized by major publications since our first vintage in 2012. The production of this wine is fairly small, averaging about 2,000 cases a year.

Since our inception in 2005, we have been producing Educated Guess Cabernet Sauvignon as an answer to Napa Cabs that are two, three, or four times its price.

Choosing wine shouldn't feel like a test. But between the appellations, the vintages, and the often \$80+ bottles staring you down — it can. We get it. We've been making those same high-stakes calls in the vineyard and cellar since 2005, obsessing over every variable so the answer in the glass is never in doubt.

Educated Guess Napa County Cabernet Sauvignon is the wine that started it all. Sourced from premier Napa Valley vineyards – including Beckstoffer Georges III, Bettinelli, and Laird Money Road – it has earned Best Buy, Top Value, and Best of Class recognition from major publications every year since its first vintage, including the #1 selling Napa Valley Cabernet under \$50.

We've done the guesswork for you. All that's left is the wine.

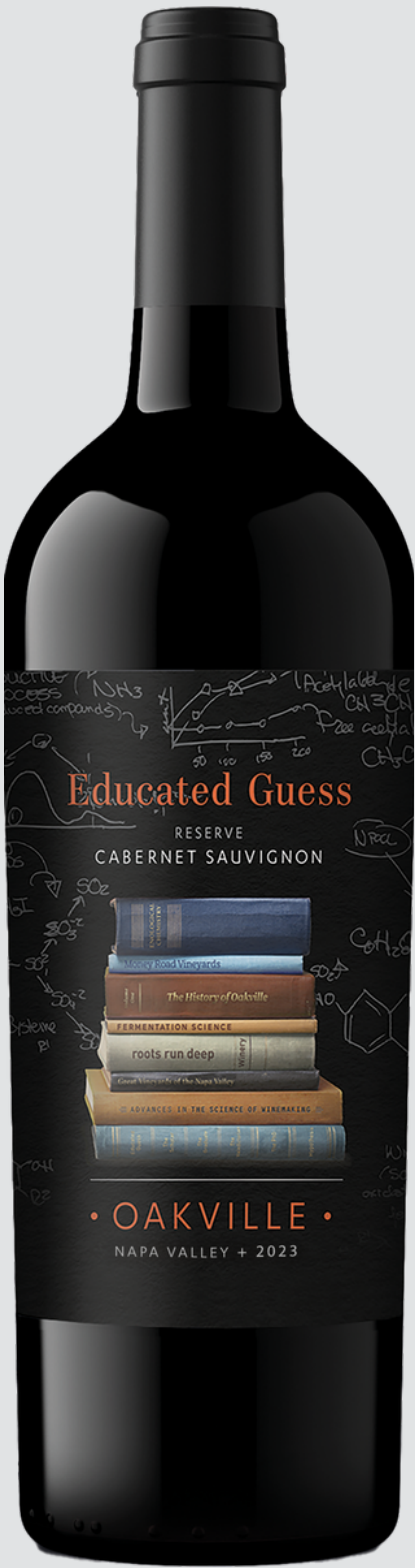

Twenty years of relationships. Two bottles that show it. Napa Valley, at its most deliberate.

Anchored by fruit from Money Road Vineyard – one of Oakville's most respected addresses – and aged 15 months in French oak, this is a Cabernet built with the kind of intention that shows up in every pour. Oakville's combination of warm days, cool evenings, and benchland soils produces fruit with a depth and concentration that commands some of the highest prices in California viticulture. Roots Run Deep has been sourcing from these vineyards for over twenty years. This Reserve is the direct result of those relationships.

There's a reason the classics become classics. Estate grown in Napa Valley and aged 10 months in French oak, this is Napa Valley Chardonnay made exactly the way it was always meant to be – rich, layered, and confident. 100% barrel fermented, 100% malolactic fermentation, and the kind of structure and depth that define the style at its best. The cool nights and varied soils of the valley preserve the natural acidity that keeps everything in balance, even as the oak and malo build richness and texture. Recognized with 94 points from the Tasting Panel and 92 points from Wine Enthusiast.

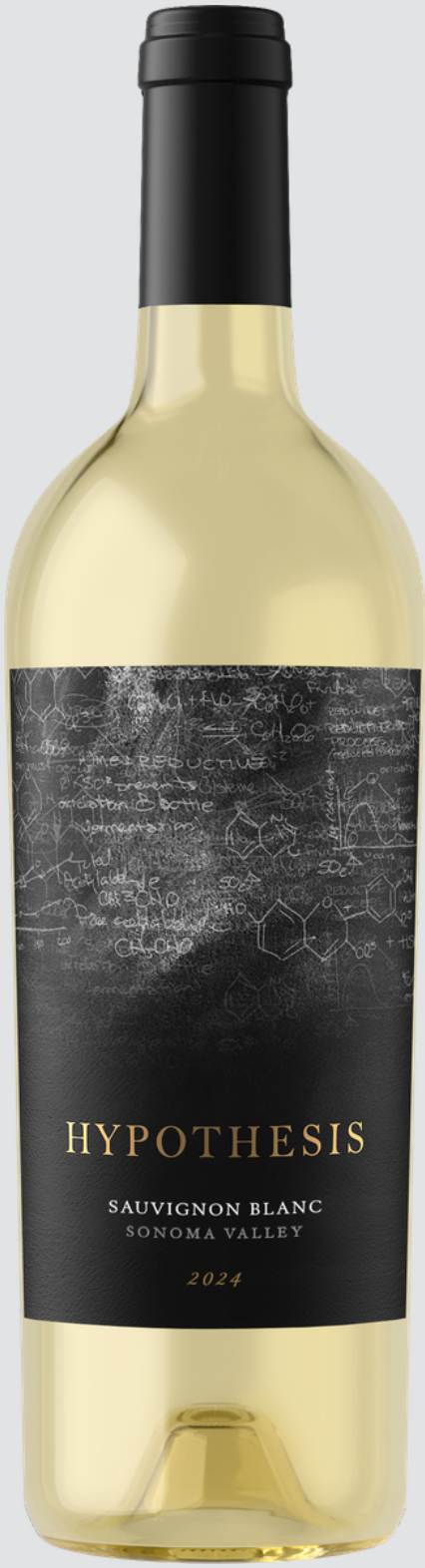

THE PURSUIT

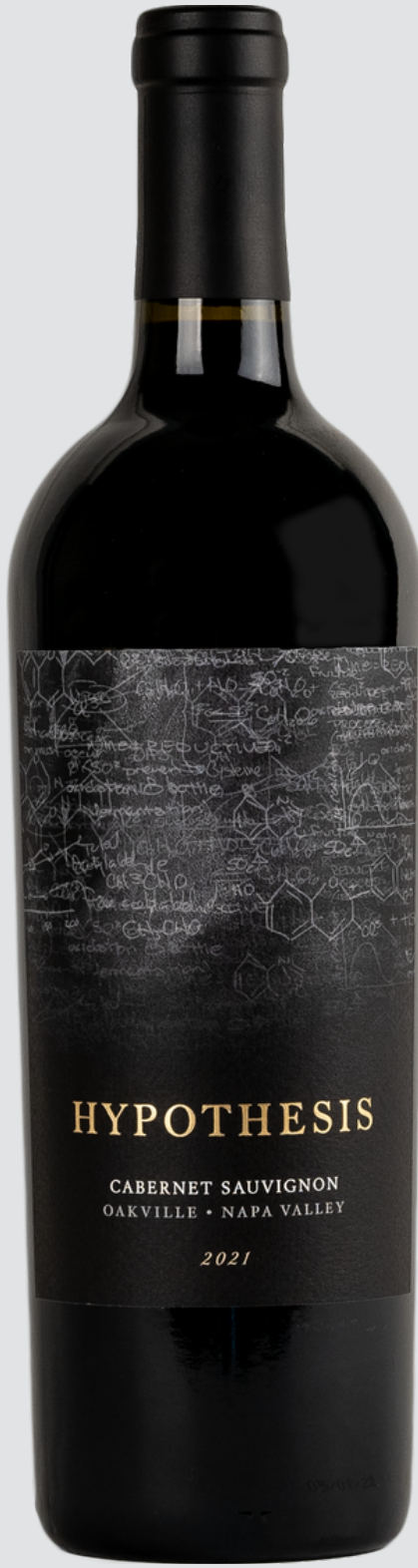
Every bottle in the Hypothesis collection is an independent discovery. These are site-specific wines built around a single question: what does this place, this vintage, this variety have to say? We source from vineyards with a specific and undeniable energy – from the tension and brightness of Sonoma Valley Sauvignon Blanc to the structure and depth of Oakville Cabernet – and let the land lead the way. The result is a collection where no two wines tell the same story.

A California answer to the Bordeaux Blanc style. Blended with Semillon for body and depth, co-fermented to fully integrate the two varieties from the very beginning of the process, then aged entirely in French oak barrels with extended time on the lees. Every decision here was made in deliberate pursuit of a Sauvignon Blanc that rewards the attention you give it – richer, more textured, and more complex than the variety typically delivers. Sourced from the warmer days and fog-cooled evenings of the Sonoma Valley, which bring a generosity and aromatic depth that suits this approach naturally. Awarded 91 points by James Suckling.

Our first Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon was released in 2010 and immediately garnered critical acclaim. Produced from one of best vineyards in all of the Napa Valley (The Money Road Vineyard in Oakville), this Cabernet Sauvignon is small in production and spends at least 18 months in French oak barrels. The Blend is primarily Oakville Cabernet Sauvignon, but typically has a splash of Napa Valley Merlot and Malbec depending on the needs of the vintage. Hypothesis Oakville Cabernet Sauvignon is a muscular wine that loves to be paired with food, but is sophisticated enough to stand on its own.

The wine has incredible depth and complexity, delicious black fruits and amazing opulence.

Bound and Determined Cabernet Sauvignon is named after a concept that is central to the founding practice of Roots Run Deep Winery. Since our inception we have been focused on a single goal: to produce outstanding wines of substance and quality that compete with wines significantly more expensive. At Roots Run Deep, we are driven, some might say hell-bent, and at the very least, persistent in our desire to make the best possible wines. Period.

Sourced from top vineyard sites in Oakville and Rutherford and aged 15 months in French oak, this is a structured, polished Cabernet that never tips into heaviness. Consistently recognized with 90+ scores across Wine Enthusiast, James Suckling, and Wine Advocate – and one of the wines our customers often credit with bringing them into the Roots Run Deep family.

Pop N' Pour was built around a simple idea: that Russian River Valley Pinot Noir – one of California's most celebrated and sought-after expressions of the variety – should feel as easy to open on a Tuesday as it does at a dinner party. No pretense. No homework. Just seriously good wine.

Sourced from two of Russian River Valley's finest vineyard sites, this Pinot captures everything the appellation does best – the fog-cooled mornings, the slow ripening, the natural tension between richness and freshness that defines the valley's most compelling wines. Light-bodied, complex, and built for the kind of drinking that doesn't require an occasion. The anti-intimidation Russian River Pinot – and one of the most approachable, repeat-purchase wines in the portfolio.

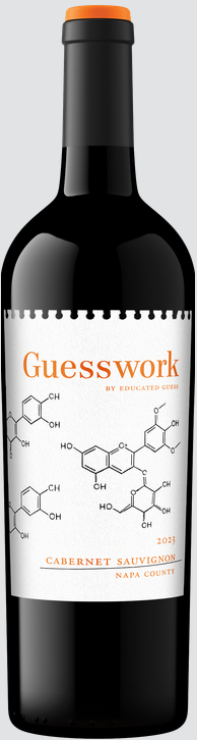

Some things in wine take a little guesswork—but this one's an easy call. Our 2023 Guesswork Chardonnay captures the bright, layered character of Napa Valley fruit with effortless balance. Rich but never overdone, it's the kind of Chardonnay that makes pairing feel intuitive—seafood, roast chicken, or just a quiet evening and a full glass. No need to overthink it—just pour, sip, and let the guessing stop there. Approximately 2,400 cases produced annually.

In Napa, there's an art to balance — and this Cabernet nails it. Crafted from select lots across Napa County and aged 12 months in French oak, it delivers the depth and structure the appellation is known for at a price that makes it an easy everyday choice. Serious Napa Cabernet without the ceremony. Approximately 5,200 cases produced annually.

Not every great wine fits neatly into an established lineup. Some of our most interesting bottles are born from moments of inspiration — whether we're experimenting with a new style, collaborating with partners, or simply following a great idea wherever it leads. Sourced from exceptional vineyard sites across the Russian River Valley and Sonoma, including fruit from the historic Bedrock Vineyard, this is a Sauvignon Blanc of genuine depth, elegance, and polish — rich and layered, bright and refined, with the kind of complexity that rewards the attention you give it. Consistently recognized by major publications. Approximately 900 cases produced annually.

Approachable in price, serious in character — a Napa Cabernet that delivers exactly what the name promises.

THE MASTERCLASS

With each exceptional vintage, we explore various high-elevation Howell Mountain vineyard sites and showcase their uniqueness, finesse, and power. These wines champion the balanced expression of Howell Mountain — where smooth structured tannins, excellent natural acidity, and layered complexity add sophistication to the intensity of the mountain fruit.

The heart of the collection is a study in how winemaking decisions shape what ends up in the glass. All four wines share the same foundation: Howell Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon. From there, the four classic Bordeaux blending grapes — Malbec, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, and Merlot — are adjusted in percentage with each bottling to create four wines that are distinct in character despite sharing the same origin. It's not about which bottle is better. It's about what changes when you shift the variables.

Crafted for the wine-curious who value detail over pretense, these wines are meant to be studied, debated, and — most importantly — celebrated. Fewer than 75 cases of each. Exclusive to wine club members and tasting salon guests.
